Open Call for Contributions

Pecha Kucha Session on design projects at the intersection of digital media and public spaces

To open up and connect the conference to the wider Berliner public, part of the conference is dedicated to the presentation of art, design, research projects and ideas dealing with the intertwining of ICT on the production of public spaces, their use and appropriation. We are looking for sustainable and interesting projects - both already implemented/realized and planed ones, and from design through theoretical to fictional ones - that address the role and impact of information and communication technologies (ICTs) in the production of public space(s).

Target groups: Researchers, practitioners, artists, designers, and graduating students

Submission & Selection

The projects are to be presented in a Pecha Kucha session, with a time maximum limit of exactly 6 minutes per presentation. Proposals must include a title, a short CV of maximum 500 characters per presenter, a short textual description (maximum 1000 characters) that gives contextual information about the project and about the motivation of presenting it in the framework of the CyberParks Finals in Berlin, and at least one visual representation of the project.

From the proposals, a selection will be compiled by a jury consisting of the conference committee members, see on the website.

Deadline & Reward

The deadline for entries is the 1st March 2018. Selected proposals will be notified until 20th March 2018.

All successful applicants will be invited for the conference dinner to be held on a boat trip on the Spree on the evening of the first conference day.
